Spain and France – Spain Trophy and the Paris World Games

Travel dates:

July 1-16, 2023

Itinerary:

July 1	Departure from Chicago airport.
July 2	Arrival Barcelona airport. Transfer to your accommodation in the Barcelona area for the Spain Trophy. Afternoon or evening coaches meeting.
July 3	Morning opening ceremony and start of the Copa Catalunya with group games.
July 4	Spain Trophy continued.
July 5	Spain Trophy continued and evening coaches/team leader reception.
July 6	Spain Trophy continued with playoffs and finals. Evening prize-giving ceremony.
July 7	Day at leisure for an optional excursion.
July 8	Day at leisure for an optional excursion.
July 9	Transfer to Barcelona airport. Flight to Paris. Arrival Paris airport. Transfer to your accommodation in the Paris area.
July 10	Start group games (1st part) Paris World Games and opening ceremony.
July 11	Group games (2nd part). Evening coaches/team leader's reception.
July 12	Group games (3rd part) and A / B play-off games (1st part).
July 13	A/B play-off games (2nd part).
July 14	A/B play-off games (3rd part).
July 15	Finals.
July 16	Transfer to Paris airport and return flight.

Sport program included:

Barcelona area: Participation in the Spain Trophy.

Paris: Participation in the Paris World Games.

Accommodation and meals included:

Spain Trophy/Barcelona area: 3-star Hotel accommodation in the Costa Brava region of Spain in a seaside resort town like Santa Susanna or Lloret de Mar.

- Daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included (at hotel).
- Hotel is usually situated within walking distance of the beach and offers a reception, safety deposit, lounge with bar and restaurant.
- Santa Susana and Lloret de Mar are located 40 miles from Barcelona offering plenty of shopping and entertainment for visitors including sandy beaches and an abundance of water sports.
- Rooms for 3 and 4 people include bathroom with shower and toilet.
- Double rooms are available at a supplement of \$20.00 per person per night. Single rooms available at a supplement of \$50.00 per person per night.

Paris World Games: 2-star hotel located in the suburbs of Paris.

- Daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included. First meal: Evening dinner July 9, and last meal breakfast on July 16. Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Lunches and dinners at the tournament meal center. Dinner July 15 is not included.
- Hotel located in Paris, outside the city center. Includes accommodation in rooms for 3 people (many rooms have one double/queen and 1 twin/bunk bed). All rooms include private bathroom.
- The hotel has a lounge, breakfast room, outdoor terrace, business center and reception area.
- Double/twin rooms (2 people per room) are available as well in the hotel at a supplement of \$10.00 per person per night. Single rooms are available at a supplement of \$54.00 per person per night.

Ground transportation included:

Barcelona area/Spain Trophy: The tournament organizer will arrange airport transfers as well as tournament shuttle transportation from the hotel to the fields and vice versa.

Paris: During the Paris World Games the tournament organizer includes free public transportation which offers public bus or train transportation between the hotels, fields, meal center and many sights in Paris. Some fields are within walking distance of the hotels. Airport transfers are included as well.

Local guide services included:

Spain Trophy: During your stay at the Spain Trophy, you can collect information or address any questions or concerns with the local tournament staff, which is readily available.

Paris World Games: During the Paris World Games, a local tour/tournament assistant will be assigned to assist your group full time each day (7 hours per day) during your stay to provide you with any assistance when necessary, and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

Options available (not included in prices)

Sport program options:

Visit and tour of a pro team stadium like the Nou Camp in Barcelona – approx. \$30.00 per person.

Travel insurance option:

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including a Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.

Not included in prices:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions.

Tournament Information

SPAIN TROPHY – BARCELONA AREA/SPAIN

Around 10-15 countries, more than 2,000 players, coaches and family come to Spain, for a week of competition, fantastic experiences and extraordinary opportunities to compete with teams from all over the world. The proximity to the sea area allows everyone to enjoy the beautiful beaches all along the Costa Brava. Barcelona is only a 45 minute drive away from Pineda de Mar, where the tournament takes place, allowing teams the opportunity to do some great sightseeing in Barcelona and, of course, visit the Nou Camp stadium, home of FC Barcelona.

Spain Trophy facts:

- Approx. 50 international youth soccer teams
- Games are played on artificial turf pitches e.g. in Malgrat de Mar, Pineda de Mar, Arenys de Munt, Sant Vicenç de Montalt, S. Susanna, S. Pol and Mataró. All stadiums have changing rooms and showers.
- Age groups: U11, U13, U15, U17 and U19 Boys.

Touristic information:

- Close to Barcelona – see La Sagrada Familia, Las Ramblas, Parque Güel, the Olympic facilities and Montjuic.
- Visit the mountaintop monastery of Montserrat
- Enjoy the beaches of the Costa Brava region of Spain
- Tour the Nou Camp, home stadium of FC Barcelona

PARIS WORLD GAMES – PARIS/FRANCE

The most recent Paris World Games had between 32 to 48 teams per age category from various countries (UK, Morocco, Tunisia, Belgium, China, Mexico, Brazil, USA, Argentina, Oman, Lebanon, Algeria, Bangladesh, Congo, Ethiopia, India, Canada, etc.). Teams included pro teams such as Olympique Lyonnais, Montpellier, PFC, PSG, etc.



Paris World Games facts:

- 100-200 soccer teams
- 62 countries
- 5 sports
- Opening ceremony in Stade Charléty.
- Games will take place on various turf fields at approx. 10-20 soccer complexes in the suburbs of Paris with some fields located close to landmarks like the Eiffel Tower.

Touristic Information:

- Sightseeing in Paris including famous landmarks like the Eiffel Tower, the Louvre, Notre Dame Cathedral, Arc de Triomphe and the Champs-Élysées.
- Visit Versailles/Palace of Versailles. Versailles, is a royal château in Versailles in the Île-de-France region of France.
- Visit Disneyland Paris.
