### Spain – Donosti Cup

#### Travel dates:

July 6-14, 2024

#### Itinerary:

- July 6 Departure from San Francisco airport.
- July 7 Arrival Bilbao, San Sebastian or Pamplona airport and transfer to San Sebastian for the Donosti Cup. Accreditations, age control, official team picture and check in.
- July 8 Start of the tournament. Evening opening ceremony at Anoeta Stadium, home of Spanish pro club Real Sociedad.
- July 9 Continuation tournament.  
Leisure time option: Walk around Parte Vieja, also known as the Old Town, in the center of San Sebastian.
- July 10 Continuation tournament. Live music at the Fan Zone. Coaches' match.  
Leisure time option: Head to the top of Monte Igueldo and enjoy the spectacular views of La Concha Bay and then head to La Concha beach after.
- July 11 Play-off's, and Live music at the Fan Zone.  
Leisure time option: Enjoy free time exploring the city of San Sebastian more.
- July 12 Donosti Cup Final round matches and finals, Donosti Cup party for all participants and Closing gala for coaches and managers. Leisure time option: Spend free time at the beach and an optional surfing lesson.
- July 13 Tournament Finals and farewell.  
Leisure time option: Visit Biarritz, France, an elegant seaside town on southwestern France's Basque coast, which has been a popular resort since European royalty began visiting in the 1800s.
- July 14 Transfer to Bilbao, San Sebastian, Pamplona or Barcelona airport. Return flight.

**San Sebastian:** Participation in the Donosti Cup.

**Accommodation and meals included:**

**Donosti Cup/San Sebastian:** Schools/Full board - daily breakfast, lunch and dinner is included. First meal is dinner July 7 and last meal is breakfast July 13. Lunch and dinner July 13 are not included.

- Accommodation in schools in San Sebastian.
- Each team will receive one classroom for its own use. The Donosti Cup will arrange bedding for all participants.
- Lunches and dinners will be served at the Donosti Cup tournament center.

**Ground transportation included:**

Airport transfers are included and during your entire stay a private bus will be available exclusively for your group – available 12 hours a day and 150 kilometers per day driving distance limitation. A trip to Biarritz, France is also included.

**Local guide services included:**

A local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time each day during your stay to provide you with any assistance when necessary, and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

**Options available (not included in prices)**

**Accommodation options Donosti Cup:**

If you decide to accommodate your team in schools, we can offer, as an option, hotel accommodation in a 4-star hotel in San Sebastian for parents and chaperones (subject to availability at time of tour booking). The hotel is usually within walking distance from the schools. All rooms have private bathroom, Wi-Fi, TV, mini bar and telephone and hotel has lounge/bar, restaurant and sometimes and outdoor swimming pool. Supplement per person for a 7-night stay is \$722.00 sharing a room for 3 people, \$1,009.00 sharing a room for 2 people and \$1,754.00 for a single room. Breakfast will be served at the hotel, lunches and dinners with your team at the tournament cafeteria. First meal is dinner July 7 and last meal is breakfast July 13. Lunch and dinner July 13 are not included.

Instead of schools we can also offer accommodation in a three or four-star hotel:

- Three-star hotel/Full board - daily breakfast, lunch and dinner. Hotel accommodation located in or maximum 10 miles from, the city center of San Sebastian. Rooms for 1-4 people all with private bathroom. The hotel has a reception area, lobby and breakfast room. Lunches and dinners will be served at the Donosti Cup tournament center. First meal is dinner July 7 and last meal is breakfast July 13. Lunch and dinner July 13 are not included. Supplement per person for a 7-night stay is \$161.00 sharing a room for 3-4 people, \$400.00 sharing a room for 2 people and \$612.00 for a single room.
- Four-star hotel/Full board - daily breakfast, lunch and dinner. Hotel accommodation located in or maximum 10-15 miles from, the city center of San Sebastian. Rooms for 1-3 people all with private bathroom. The hotel has a reception area, lobby, restaurant and bar and sometimes and outdoor swimming pool. Lunches and dinners will be served at the Donosti Cup tournament center. First meal is dinner July 7 and last meal is breakfast July 13. Lunch and dinner July 13 are not included. Supplement per person for a 7-night stay is \$372.00 sharing a room for 3 people, \$409.00 sharing a room for 2 people and \$1,017.00 for a single room.

Please notice all hotel accommodation options are subject to availability upon tour booking.

**Extra day/night option:**

We can add an extra day at the front of the end tour (departure July 5 instead of July 6). Approx. costs for an extra day/night can range from \$20.00 per person (in case of school accommodation) to \$150.00 or more per person in case of hotels depending on the level of accommodation chosen.

## Tournament Information

### DONOSTI CUP - SAN SEBASTIAN/SPAIN

In 2024, approximately 800 teams will participate. That makes this tournament one of the biggest tournaments in Southern Europe. The Donosti Cup tournament headquarters are located in and around the Estadio Anoeta, the stadium of Real Sociedad. Many of the games are played at the official training complex for Real Sociedad with 4 grass fields, a small stadium and 1 artificial grass field. San Sebastian is a beautiful city in the Northern part of Spain located at the Bay of Biscay.



#### Donosti Cup facts:

- 700+ international youth soccer teams
- Guaranteed minimum 4 matches per team
- The Opening Ceremony of the tournament takes place in Estadio Anoeta, the home stadium of La Liga team Real Sociedad.

#### Touristic information:

- San Sebastian: On the banks of the Bay of Biscay and surrounded by green mountains, San Sebastian is a delightful city that provides a feast for the senses. The best-known image of San Sebastián is its almost perfectly shell-shaped bay, widely considered to be one of the most beautiful in the world. The city is home to 180,000 people and is the cultural and tourist capital of the Basque Country. The city has beautiful constructions, such as the Grand Casino (present Town Hall), the Miramar Palace, summer residence of the Court, or the bridges over the Urumea River. The houses of the Old Quarter, full of bars and restaurants, date from previous times. In the Old Quarter, the local passion for gastronomy is palpable. From the miniature cuisine of the 'pintxos' to the restaurants of the creative cuisine masters, good eating is one of Donostia's commandments.
- Biarritz – France: Make a trip to this popular and lively beach resort town on the Atlantic coast in southwest France which is about a 45-minute drive from San Sebastian.

**Paris World Games:** Two-star hotel located in the suburbs of Paris.

- Daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included (10 lunches and dinners). First meal: Breakfast July 8, and last meal breakfast on July 14. Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Lunches and dinners are served the tournament meal centers (nearby university cafeteria/restaurant). Lunch and dinner July 13 are not included.
- Hotel located in Paris, outside the city center. Includes accommodation in rooms for 3 people (many rooms have one double/queen and 1 twin/bunk bed). All rooms include private bathroom.
- The hotel has a lounge, breakfast room, outdoor terrace, business center and reception area.
- Double/twin rooms (2 people per room) are available as well in the hotel at a supplement of \$10.00 per person per night. Single rooms are available at a supplement of \$54.00 per person per night.

Depending on your group's budget, we recommend upgrading to a 3-star hotel accommodation because 3-star hotels have air-conditioning. For more information see accommodation options below.

**Ground transportation:**

During the Paris World Games the tournament organizer includes free public transportation which offers public bus or train transportation between the hotels, fields, meal center and many sights in Paris. Some fields are within walking distance of the hotels. Airport transfers are included as well. The free public transportation starts July 8.

**Local guide services included:**

A local tour/tournament assistant will be assigned to assist your group full time each day (7 hours per day) during your stay to provide you with any assistance when necessary, and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

**Options available (not included in prices)**

**Accommodation options Paris World Games:**

Option 1:

Accommodation in a three-star hotel – daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

These hotels are typically located in Paris outside the city center within walking distance of public transportation. Hotels have WIFI, a restaurant that is open for lunch and dinner, meeting rooms, lounge and sometimes and outdoor terrace. The hotel has rooms for 1-4 people per room (limited number of quad rooms for 4 people available). All rooms include private bathroom. Supplement for triple and quad rooms (3-4 people per room) is \$15.00 per person per night. First meal: Breakfast July 8, and last meal breakfast on July 14. Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Lunches and dinners are served the tournament meal centers (nearby university cafeteria/restaurant). Lunch and dinner July 13 are not included.

**Option 2:**

Four-star hotel – daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included. Hotel located in Paris outside the city center within walking distance of public transportation. Hotel has air-conditioned rooms with free WIFI, a restaurant that is open for lunch and dinner, patio/outdoor terrace, lounge/bar area, spa, business center, meeting rooms and sometimes an outdoor/indoor swimming pool.

The hotel has rooms for 1-3 people per room. All rooms include private bathroom. Supplement for triple room (3 people per room) is \$114.00 per person per night. Supplement for rooms for 2 people (with one double/queen or 2 twin beds) is \$154.00 per person per night. Supplement for a single room is \$240.00 per person per night. First meal: Breakfast July 8, and last meal breakfast on July 14. Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Lunches and dinners are served the tournament meal centers (nearby university cafeteria/restaurant). Lunch and dinner July 13 are not included.

**Extra day/night option:**

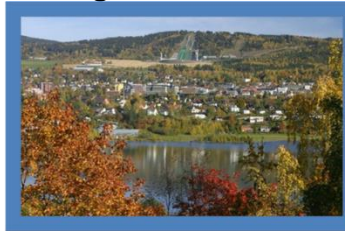

### NORWAY CUP – OLSO/NORWAY

Ever since the start, the NORWAY CUP has been the biggest tournament in the world. More than 1,700 teams from many different countries will participate at the 2024 edition. All games will be played on grass fields! Some Norway Cup facts: 1,700 teams, 32,000 participants, 50 nations, 80 fields, 3,810 games and 350 referees.



#### Norway Cup facts:

- 1,700+ international youth soccer teams
- 32,000 participants from 52 different countries
- Norway Cup always starts with a spectacular parade through Oslo, where participants wear their team-kits and wave the various country flags.
- Approx. 60 well maintained grass and artificial fields in and around the center of Oslo.

#### Touristic information:

- Oslo: Oslo, the oldest of the Scandinavian Capitals, was founded by Harald Hadrade in the 11th Century and is surrounded by Mountains at the head of a 70-mile fjord. Oslo is an easy-going city where history meets modernity. The city boasts world-class museums, a lively nightlife and plenty of outdoor activities and many locals are keen hikers, skiers or sailors.
- The Nobel Peace Center: this museum tells the story about the Nobel Peace Prize, Peace Prize winners and their work, and also the story about Alfred Nobel. The peace center is also a place for debates regarding social questions.
- The Astrup Fearnley Museum: Visit Astrup Fearnley museum and see exciting, modern art at the museum. You'll get to meet many different artists with many different expressions.
- Vikingship house: Here you can find a unique collection of objects and ships from the Vikings.
- Akershus fortress: To Oslo, Akershus Fortress is an important part of the city's identity. The city centre was established within the walls of the fortress during 1624. The area around the fortress is popular amongst tourists during summer.
