- July 24 Departure from Newark airport.
- July 25 Arrival London airport. Transfer to your accommodation.
- July 26 Morning training session with a Premiership Club Academy coach. Rest of day at leisure for sightseeing in London.
- July 27 Day at leisure for sightseeing London including stadium tour of Stamford Bridge, home of Chelsea FC.
- July 28 Start of the London Cup with group matches.
- July 29 Continuation of London Cup group matches and playoffs.
- July 30 Continuation of London Cup with playoff matches.
- July 31 London Cup finals followed by prize giving ceremony. Afternoon/evening optional visit to the FA Community Shield pro match (subject to availability based on match date).
- August 1 Transfer to London airport and return flight home.

Accommodation and meals included:

London: 4-star hotel accommodation in the London area.

- Daily breakfast included.
- Hotel accommodation in the London area on the outskirts of London approx. 20-22 miles from the center of London and approx. 20 miles from the tournament venue.
- Includes double/twin rooms for 2 people per room with en-suite (private) bathroom, trouser press, hairdryer, tea/coffee maker, safe, phone and TV.
- The hotel has a reception area, restaurant, lounge/bar, gym and swimming pool.

Ground transportation included:

During your entire stay a private bus will be available exclusively for your group each day – 13 hours a day.

Local guide services included:

Access to local tournament staff during your stay to provide you with any assistance when necessary, and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

Sport program options:

- We can arrange tickets to the FA Community Shield match, if it takes place during your dates of travel. Ticket costs will be determined when match date is announced and tickets go on sale, but we estimate match ticket costs will be approx. \$50-\$125 or more per person.

Travel insurance option:

Accident, illness and trip cancellation/interruption insurance – more information will be sent to you after booking. Approx. costs for trip insurance is \$67.00 - \$195.00+ depending on the age of the participant and the trip price.

Touristic information London

LONDON STADIUM TOURS: Tour one of the famous pro team stadiums in London like Wembley, Emirates (Arsenal FC) or Stamford Bridge (Chelsea)

THE LONDON EYE: The London Eye is a giant Ferris wheel on the South Bank of the River Thames in London, England. The entire structure is 135 meters (443 ft.) tall and the wheel has a diameter of 120 meters (394 ft.). It is the tallest Ferris wheel in Europe. Includes 30-minute rotation, Samsung interactive capsule guides, entry to 4D cinema experience.

TOWER OF LONDON: The massive White Tower is a typical example of Norman military architecture, whose influence was felt throughout the kingdom. It was built on the Thames by William the Conqueror to protect London and assert his power. The Tower of London – an imposing fortress with many layers of history, which has become one of the symbols of royalty – was built around the White Tower.

WINDSOR CASTLE: A visit to the Castle includes the State Apartments, St George's Chapel and Queen Mary's Dolls' House. Windsor Castle is a royal residence at Windsor in the English county of Berkshire. The castle is notable for its long association with the British royal family and for its architecture.

HAMPTON COURT PALACE: Hampton Court Palace is a royal palace in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, Greater London, in the historic county of Middlesex; it has not been inhabited by the British Royal Family since the 18th century.

LONDON DUNGEONS: The London Dungeon is a London tourist attraction which recreates various gory and macabre historical events in a gallows humor style aimed at younger audiences. It uses a mixture of live actors, special effects and rides.
