

International Soccer Tour 2023 Itinerary Loudoun Soccer England – London and Chester/Manchester

Travel dates:

March 31-April 9, 2023.

Itinerary:

March 31 Departure from Washington-Dulles airport.

April 1 Arrival London airport. Transfer to your accommodation.

April 2 Sightseeing London – options include The Tower of London, The Houses of Parliament,

Buckingham Palace and London's newest and highest attraction, The London Eye, with its

spectacular views over London. Evening game vs. a local team.

April 3 Morning training session with a London area pro club coach.

Visit Hampton Court Palace and Windsor Castle. For almost 200 years, Hampton Court Palace was at the center of court life, politics and national history. Windsor Castle is an

official residence of The Queen and the largest occupied castle in the world.

April 4 Enjoy the day sightseeing in London. Visit the Chelsea Village MegaShop, Trafalgar

Square and Covent Garden shopping precinct. Evening game vs. a local team.

April 5 More sightseeing in London, including a tour of Emirates Stadium, home of Arsenal FC.

Time permitting, other options include St. Paul's Cathedral, Westminster Abbey,

Bourough Market and/or Hyde Park.

April 6 Transfer to your accommodation in Manchester. Evening game vs. a local team.

April 7 Morning training session with a Manchester area pro club coach.

Sightseeing in Manchester – options include the National Football Museum, The Trafford Centre and Manchester Museum. Or visit Chester. Chester is a magical city over 2000 years old; it is the most complete walled city in Britain. Walk the walls – 2 miles of entirely walk able walls, studded with historic towers and a bird's eye view of the city center. Look over the other side of the wall for a view of the Welsh mountains in the distance. Afterwards you can head for the Roman Amphitheater and The Chester

Cathedral (14th century church).

April 8 More sightseeing Manchester, including a tour of Old Trafford stadium and museum,

home of Manchester United. Evening game vs. a local team.

April 9 Transfer to Manchester or London or airport. Return flight.

Sport program included:

- We will arrange a total of 4 games per team (two in London and two in Manchester)
- We will arrange one training session per team in London with a youth academy coach from a proclub like Everton FC, Chelsea FC, Arsenal, Tottenham Hotspurs or Fulham FC.
- We will arrange one training session per team in Manchester with a youth academy coach from a pro club like Manchester City, etc.
- We have included two pro team stadium tours Emirates Stadium (Arsenal FC) in London and Old Trafford in Manchester.

Accommodation and meals included:

London: 4-star Hotel accommodation in London.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Hotel accommodation in the outskirts of London about 10-15 miles from the city center.
- Rooms for 3 people with en-suite bathroom, trouser press, hairdryer, tea/coffee maker and TV.
- The hotel offers a restaurant, lounge/bar, fitness center Wi-Fi.
- Double/twin rooms (2 people per room) available at a supplement of \$20.00 per person per night.

Manchester area: 3-star Hotel accommodation in Manchester.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Hotel accommodation in Manchester, approx. 8-10 miles outside the city center.
- Rooms for 3 people with private facilities, satellite TV and phone.
- The hotel has a restaurant/lounge, indoor heated pool, sauna/solarium and fitness center.

Ground transportation included:

Each team will have a private bus exclusively for the team (two teams = two busses) daily for the duration of the tour -10 hours a day.

Local guide services included:

Each team will have a local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with the groups full time each day during your stay in each destination to provide you with any assistance when necessary, and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.



Options available (not included in prices)

Sport program options:

- Subject to availability we might be able to arrange an optional training session with an English
 FA coaches at St. George's Park, headquarters of the English FA, along with a tour of the
 facilities. Approx. supplement for a 2-hour session will be around \$800 total per team.
- We can arrange tickets to pro games, subject to availability. Ticket costs will depend on the game, but usually ticket costs range from approx. \$75-\$150 per person depending on the game.
- A 2-hour training session with your own coaching staff costs \$260.00 per 2 hours.

Travel insurance option:

Touristic information London

LONDON STADIUM TOURS: Tour one of the famous pro team stadiums in London like Wembley, Emirates (Arsenal FC) or Stamford Bridge (Chelsea)

THE LONDON EYE: The London Eye is a giant Ferris wheel on the South Bank of the River Thames in London, England. The entire structure is 135 meters (443 ft.) tall and the wheel has a diameter of 120 meters (394 ft.). It is the tallest Ferris wheel in Europe. Includes 30-minute rotation, Samsung interactive capsule guides, entry to 4D cinema experience.

TOWER OF LONDON: The massive White Tower is a typical example of Norman military architecture, whose influence was felt throughout the kingdom. It was built on the Thames by William the Conqueror to protect London and assert his power. The Tower of London – an imposing fortress with many layers of history, which has become one of the symbols of royalty – was built around the White Tower.

WINDSOR CASTLE: A visit to the Castle includes the State Apartments, St George's Chapel and Queen Mary's Dolls' House. Windsor Castle is a royal residence at Windsor in the English county of Berkshire. The castle is notable for its long association with the British royal family and for its architecture.

HAMPTON COURT PALACE: Hampton Court Palace is a royal palace in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, Greater London, in the historic county of Middlesex; it has not been inhabited by the British Royal Family since the 18th century.

LONDON DUNGEONS: The London Dungeon is a London tourist attraction which recreates various gory and macabre historical events in a gallows humor style aimed at younger audiences. It uses a mixture of live actors, special effects and rides.

Touristic information Chester/Manchester and Northwest England

Chester and Manchester both are located in the Northwest part of England. Chester lies right on the border between Wales and England. Chester is one of the best preserved walled cities in Britain. It has a number of medieval buildings, but some of the black-and-white buildings within the city center are Victorian restorations. Manchester lies within the United Kingdom's second-most populous urban area, with a population of 2.55 million. Manchester is notable for its architecture, culture, musical exports, media links, scientific and engineering output, social impact, sports clubs and transport connections. Manchester is home to two top EPL clubs, Manchester United and Manchester City FC.

NATIONAL FOOTBALL MUSEUM: The National Football Museum is a museum at the Urbis building in Manchester city center founded to preserve, conserve and interpret several important collections of association football memorabilia. The museum was originally situated in Deepdale, Preston, Lancashire, but moved to Manchester in 2012.

IMPERIAL WAR MUSEUM: Visit the award-winning IWM North to discover powerful stories that reveal how war shapes lives, from a soldier's last letter home to the twisted steel of New York City's World Trade Center. Housed in Daniel Libeskind's iconic building representing a globe torn apart by conflict, IWM North offers a free day out like no other.

TRAFFORD CENTER: The Trafford Center is a largest indoor shopping center in Western Europe and leisure complex in Greater Manchester, England. Situated in the Metropolitan Borough of Trafford, the Centre is situated close to the Trafford Park industrial estate and lies approximately five miles west of Manchester city center.

THE BEATLES MUSEUM: The Beatles Story is a visitor attraction dedicated to the 1960s pop group The Beatles in Liverpool, England.

BLACKPOOL PLEASURE BEACH: Blackpool Pleasure Beach is an amusement park and resort situated along the Fylde coast in Blackpool, Lancashire, England. It is one of the top twenty most-visited amusement parks in the world.
