# OCTOBER 24, 2026- NOVEMBER 1, 2026



- Oct. 24 Departure from Salt Lake City International Airport. Flight to Milan via Paris.
- Oct. 25 Arrival Milan and transfer to your accommodation in Florence, Italy. Rest of day at leisure.
- Oct. 26 Day trip to Siena - distinguished by its medieval brick buildings. The fan-shaped central square, Piazza del Campo, is the site of the Palazzo Pubblico, the Gothic town hall, and Torre del Mangia, a slender 14th-century tower with sweeping views from its distinctive white crown. The city's 17 historic "contrade" (districts) extend outward from the piazza. **Evening game vs. a local team**
- Oct. 27 Day trip to Pisa, known for its Torre Pendente (Leaning Tower) and Viareggio, a popular seaside resort on the Mediterranean.
- Oct. 28 Sightseeing tour in Florence. You will visit major sights such as the Duomo, Ponte Vecchio, the Oltrarno, the Palazzo Vecchio, Piazza della Signoria, and Piazza Michelangelo. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Oct. 29 Arrival at Munich airport. Transfer to your accommodation in the Munich area.
- Oct. 30 Take a bus tour past all of Munich's famous sights such as the Peterskirche; the Marienplatz, with the and New Town Hall; the Residenz, the Royal Palace; the Deutsches Museum; the Munich Municipal Museum; the Frauenkirche and the St. Michaelskirche. A trip to the Olympic Village, built for the 1972 Olympics, will be included as well.
- Oct. 31 Morning optional training session with your coaching staff. Day excursion to Dachau. The name has been a symbol of horror and despair since the first Nazi concentration camp was built here in 1933. There is now a museum that houses an exhibition to document this grim piece of history, and/or, excursion to Schloss (Castle) Nymphenburg. **Evening game vs. a local club.**
- Nov. 1 Transfer to Florence/Bologna/Milan airport and return flight.

Sightseeing admission fees are not included in the prices but can be added and pre-booked based on your group's specific wishes. Consult us for more information.

### ROUND TRIP AIRFARE INCLUDED

### SPORT PROGRAM INCLUDED:

We will arrange 3 games in total per team – 1 in Munich and 2 in Florence.



### ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS INCLUDED:

**Florence: 4-star Hotel accommodation in Montecatini near Florence.**

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Montecatini is a tourist resort 30 miles from Florence.
- The hotel has a restaurant, bar, and lounge with TV.
- Accommodation in triple rooms (3 people per room with three twin beds). All rooms have TV, telephone, and private bathroom. Double rooms are available at a supplement of \$15.00 per person per night.

**Munich: 4-star Hotel accommodation on the outskirts of Munich.**

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Hotel in Munich just outside the city center.
- The hotel has a restaurant and bar/lounge.
- Includes accommodation in triple rooms (3 people per room – 1 double bed and 1 twin bed). All rooms have a TV, telephone, and a private bathroom. Double rooms are available at a supplement of \$10.00 per person per night and single rooms are available at a supplement of \$50.00.
- Please be aware that rooms in Europe are smaller than we are used to in the USA.
- Please note that quad rooms for 4 people are very limited in Europe due to smaller hotel room sizes. While we can request one for a family of 4, it's not guaranteed and may be less comfortable. We recommend booking two double rooms instead, which involves a per-person supplement.



### GROUND TRANSPORTATION INCLUDED:

During your entire stay, a private bus will be available exclusively for your group – 10 hours a day.



### LOCAL GUIDE SERVICES INCLUDED:

A local bi-lingual tour manager will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time each day during your stay in each destination to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

### NOT INCLUDED ARE:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions.

### SPORT PROGRAM OPTIONS

- We can arrange tickets for pro games, subject to availability. Ticket costs will depend on the game, but usually, ticket costs range from approx. \$75.00-\$150.00 or more per person depending on the game.
- Visit and tour of a pro team stadium – between \$25.00 and \$35.00 per person.
- Training sessions with a coach from an Italian or German pro club – cost approx. \$1,000.00 per session (90 minutes), including field hire. Consult us for more information.
- We can arrange a training session for your team with an Italian Soccer Federation coach at Coverciano (near Florence), headquarters of the Italian Soccer Federation (subject to availability) along with a tour of the facilities. Costs are \$69.00 per player and \$32.00 per non-player.
- A 2-hour training session with your own coaching staff – costs \$260.00 per 2 hours.

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team/tour website.

# SIGHTSEEING IN FLORENCE

RECOMMEND EXCURSION(S) TO PRE-BOOK ARE THE TOWER OF PISA AND THE UFFIZI GALLERY



## TOWER OF PISA

**Prices: Leaning Tower \$33.00 - Cathedral admission included**

The Leaning Tower of Pisa is the campanile, or freestanding bell tower, of the cathedral of the Italian city of Pisa, known worldwide for its unintended tilt to one side. It is situated behind the Cathedral and is the third oldest structure in Pisa's Cathedral Square after the Cathedral and the Baptistry. The tower's tilt began during construction, caused by an inadequate foundation on ground too soft on one side to properly support the structure's weight.

## UFFIZI GALLERY

**Prices: Adults: \$37.00 per person.**

The Uffizi Gallery is an art museum located in Florence, and among the oldest and most famous art museums in Europe. In high season (particularly in July), waiting times can be up to five hours. Visitors who reserve a ticket in advance have a substantially shorter wait. Tickets can also be purchased from a lesser-used ticket window at the Orsanmichele that serves multiple museums.

## COOKING CLASS

**Prices: \$48.00 per person – max. 28 people per class.**

Join an expert Italian chef for a memorable culinary experience in Florence, Italy. Explore fantastic authentic local neighborhood and take part in a hands-on 3-course pasta making class. Meet your chef and visit a local produce market first. Afterwards, you will reach the food studio and start your culinary adventure! Conqueror to protect London and assert his power. The Tower of London – an imposing fortress with many layers of history, which has become one of the symbols of royalty – was built around the White Tower.

## THE PONTE VECCHIO

**Prices: Free of charge.**

The Ponte Vecchio ("Old Bridge") is a Medieval stone closed-spandrel segmental arch bridge over the Arno River, in Florence, Italy, noted for still having shops built along it, as was once common. Butchers initially occupied the shops, but the present tenants are jewelers, art dealers and souvenir sellers. The Ponte Vecchio's two neighbouring bridges are the Ponte Santa Trinita and the Ponte alle Grazie.

## SIENA - PIAZZA DEL CAMPO IN SIENA

**Prices: Free of charge.**

Piazza del Campo in Siena is considered one of the most beautiful places in the world. It has a characteristic shell-shape divided in 9 slices; you can admire this form from the top of the tower del Mangia. The Torre del Mangia in Siena requires an admission fee of \$30.00 - U11s Free.

### ALLIANZ ARENA

**Minimum order of 20 tickets at \$39.00 each.**

The Allianz is a football stadium in Munich, Bavaria, Germany with a 69,901 seating capacity. Widely known for its exterior of inflated ETFE plastic panels, it is the first stadium in the world with a full color-changing color exterior. Located at the northern edge of Munich's Schwabing-Freimann borough, it is the third largest arena in Germany behind Signal Iduna Park in Dortmund and the Olympiastadion in Berlin.

### NYMPHENBURG PALACE

**Prices: Adult \$17 and Under 18's and students are free**

With this ticket you can visit the palace, the Marstallmuseum (carriages and sleighs), the Museum of Nymphenburg Porcelain and the park palaces (Amalienburg, Badenburger, Pagodenburg, Magdalenenklause). The Nymphenburg Palace, i. e., "Castle of the Nymph (or Nymphs)", is a Baroque palace in Munich, Bavaria, southern Germany. The palace was the main summer residence of the rulers of Bavaria of the House of Wittelsbach.

### DACHAU CONCENTRATION CAMP

**Minimum age: 14**

Individual entry without a guided tour is free. Dachau concentration camp was the first of the Nazi concentration camps opened in Germany, intended to hold political prisoners. It is located on the grounds of an abandoned munitions factory near the medieval town of Dachau, about 16 km (9.9 mi) northwest of Munich in the state of Bavaria, in southern Germany. Opened in 1933 by Heinrich Himmler, its purpose was enlarged to include forced labor, and eventually, the imprisonment of Jews, ordinary German and Austrian criminals, and eventually foreign nationals from countries that Germany occupied or invaded. It was finally liberated in 1945.

### OLYMPIC PARK OF MUNICH

**Price: Free of charge**

The Olympiapark in Munich, Germany, is an Olympic Park which was constructed for the 1972 Summer Olympics. Found in the area of Munich known as the "Oberwiesenfeld" ("upper meadow-field"), the Park continues to serve as a venue for cultural, social, and religious events such as events of worship. The Park is administered by Olympiapark München GmbH, a holding company fully owned by the state capital of Munich.
