**Travel dates:**

June 20-27, 2025

**Itinerary:**

June 20	Departure from Detroit airport.
June 21	Arrival at Rome airport and transfer to Sabaudia, Latina or one of the surrounding cities. Accreditations, age control and check-in.
June 22	Leisure Day – Rome tour. It's easy to see why Rome's one of the most-visited places on the planet: There's history everywhere (the Pantheon, the Colosseum, and more), sculptural masterpieces in almost every piazza, and-of course amazing food. Evening opening ceremony.
June 23	Start of the Italy World Games – group games. Leisure time option: Boat Trip in San Felice Circeo.
June 24	Continuation of the Italy World Games – group games. Leisure time option: Miami Beach Acqua Park.
June 25	Italy World Games play-off games. Leisure time option: ZooMarine; a combination of a water park and a zoo.
June 26	Tournament Finals and farewell.
June 27	Transfer to Rome airport. Return flight.

**Sabaudia:** Participation at the Paris World Games.

A local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full-time each day during your stay to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

## Tournament Information

### ITALY WORLD GAMES – Latina and Sabaudia and surrounding cities.

In 2025, approximately 80-100 teams will participate, making this one of the biggest summer tournaments in Italy. The Italy World Games will be an international soccer tournament in combination with sight-seeing Rome and beach time in one of the most beautiful beach towns south of Rome. The tournament will be played on artificial fields south of Rome and maybe even in Rome.



#### Italy World Games facts:

- 80+ international youth soccer teams.
- Guaranteed minimum of 4 matches per team.
- Opening Ceremony

#### Touristic information:

- Sightseeing Rome. Visit the Colosseum, Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps, the Arch of Constantine, the Palatine Hill, the most famous of the seven hills of Rome. Then, take a walk along the Via Sacra or 'Sacred Way', the main path through the Roman Forum that was used for triumphal processions, and visit the temple which houses the altar where Julius Caesar was cremated.
- Boat Trip in San Felice Circeo – this area offers a natural paradise with endless caves. It is the most fascinating itinerary of the Circeo National Park with about forty caves of particular beauty, the most important are the Grotta delle Capre, Grotta del Fossellone, Grotta dell'Impiso and many others. All are fascinating and rich in history.
- Miami Beach Acqua Park.
- Stadio Olimpico – This soccer stadium is the home of soccer clubs Lazio & Roma plus the venue for the Coppa Italia final & many international games.
