own). Sightseeing Dortmund. Options include Old Town of Dortmund and the Alter Markt, the Old Market, a large pedestrian-friendly area with shops, St. Reinold's Church, Westfalenpark and a tour of Signal Iduna Park, home stadium of Borussia Dortmund.

July 11 More sightseeing in Dortmund, or make a day trip to Cologne or Dusseldorf.

July 12 Transfer to Dortmund, Dusseldorf, Cologne or Frankfurt airport. Flight to Gothenburg or

Copenhagen airport. Arrival Gothenburg or Copenhagen airport and transfer to your

accommodation in Gothenburg.

July 13 Start group matches Gothia Cup.

Evening opening ceremony in the Ullevi stadium.

July 14 Group matches.

Evening team leader reception.

July 15 Group matches.

July 16 Playoff matches.

Dortmund: 3-star Hotel accommodation in Dortmund (Mercure Hotel Dortmund city or similar).

- The hotel offers a lounge, bar and restaurant.


Gothia Cup: Hotel accommodation in the 4-star Aby Hotel in Molendal, just outside of Gothenburg.

- The hotel has a restaurant, lobby bar and fitness center. The hotel is located by Åby Arena and has Tivoli inspired rooms adjacent to exhibition center, racecourse, gastronomy and gym.

The hotel option includes breakfast daily only. The Gothia Cup offers a meal plan as well; self-service, cafeteria type meals served at the schools. Costs are approx. \$165.00 per person for 12 meals and \$90.00 per person for 6 meals (lunch or dinner).

Ground transportation included:

During your entire stay in Dortmund a private bus will be available exclusively for your group – 10 hours a day. During the Gothia Cup the tournament arranges special shuttle transportation. On free days during the tournament we can arrange a private chartered bus for excursions (for an additional charge).

The opening ceremony at Ullevi Stadium attracts 50,000 spectators and participants, while 1,500 volunteers guarantee that this will remain the tournament of all tournaments! First-class



competition on first-class fields is only part of this great festive week. Located on Sweden's beautiful west coast, Gothenburg offers all the excitement of a major seaport city, as well as fine beaches, water sports, boat trips, shopping and dining. The 2018 Gothia Cup will again be the world's largest and prestigious soccer party for both players and fans.

Gothia Cup facts:

- 1,600+ international youth soccer teams
- 40,000 participants from 80 different countries
- One of the highlights of the tournament is the Olympic style opening ceremony which takes
 place in Ullevi Stadium, home stadium of Swedish pro club IFK Göteborg, with 50,000+
 spectators.
