Travel dates:

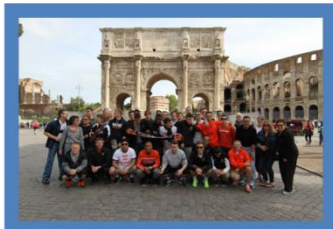
July 5-13, 2024.

Itinerary:

- July 5 Departure from San Diego or Los Angeles airport.
- July 6 Arrival Milan, Vernice or Bologna and transfer to your accommodation in the Rimini area for the San Marino Cup.
- July 7 Day at leisure. We recommend exploring the beaches and town of Rimini by foot. Rimini and the surrounding towns are full of restaurants, shops, cafes and plenty of sights to see like the Tiberius Bridge, Arco d'Augusto and more.
- July 8 Morning start San Marino Cup with preliminary games.
- July 9 Preliminary matches San Marino Cup.
- July 10 Preliminaries. Evening Welcome Gala dinner for 2 coaches from each team.
- July 11 Intermediaries/play-off matches. Evening tournament disco.
- July 12 Finals and prize-giving ceremony.
- July 13 Transfer to Milan, Venice or Bologna airport and return flight.

Sport program included:

San Marino: Participation in the San Marino Cup.

Accommodation and meals included:

San Marino Cup: 4-star (Italian classification) Hotel accommodation in or around Rimini.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Located close to the cozy boulevard along the 'Riviera Romagnola' where you'll find a variety of bars, restaurants, terraces and places of entertainment.
- All rooms for 3 and 4 people (hotels have limited number of quad rooms available) have a private bathroom with wash basin and open shower as well as air conditioning. All rooms are equipped with TV and telephone and most rooms do have a small fridge as well. Rooms can have a queen bed for 2 people and/or bunk beds.
- Facilities include a dining room and most hotels have a bar, TV-lounge, terrace and sometimes outdoor swimming pool and sauna.
- Double rooms are available at a supplement of \$25.00 per person per night.

We can offer the option to accommodate your group in a 3-star level hotel instead of 4-star level hotel which would reduce the participant price by approx. \$250.00 per person. However, many 3-star hotels do not have air-conditioning. Only 4-star hotels are guaranteed to have air-conditioning which is why we recommend accommodating your group in a 4-star hotel.

Ground transportation included:

Airport transfers on arrival and departure. From July 8-12 a private bus will be available exclusively for your group – 8-9 hours a day. On request, and at a supplement, we can arrange for a private bus on July 7 as well - approx. costs \$1,000.00 total for bus hire for the day for a 50-53 seat bus.

Note: the bus included and described above will be available for local excursions within 60 kilometers of distance from San Marino/ Adriatic Riviera.

Local guide services included:

A local bi-lingual tour manager will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time each day during your stay to provide you with any assistance when necessary, and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

Travel insurance option:

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including a Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.

Not included in prices:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions. This applies to per person admissions for sights and attractions as well as city admission fees (called ZTL fees) for the touring bus in Italy. These ZTL fees are approx. \$100.00 - \$250.00 when you enter a city ZTL zone. There are options to avoid these fees – consult us for more information on this.
- Single rooms in hotels. Single rooms are available at a supplement of \$40.00 per person per night on top of the double room supplements outlined in the accommodation description.

Tournament Information

SAN MARINO CUP - REPUBLIC OF SAN MARINO/ITALY

The San Marino Cup will take place on the nice grass and turf soccer fields of the Republic of San Marino whose territory is part of the Italian peninsula. The San Marino Olympic Sports Center with the Olympic soccer stadium of Serravalle will be hosting the tournament headquarters, the great opening ceremony and the main final games. Other quality soccer fields will be available in the Rimini, Riccione, Villa Verucchio and San Marino area. The largest Italian youth soccer tournament for boys and girls - 75 teams, 18 countries, 4 Continents and more than 2000 participants were represented. If you are still thinking about it, hurry up! We are waiting to welcome you at the San Marino Cup, a tournament of your dreams!



San Marino Cup facts:

- 100 international youth soccer teams
- 18 Countries, 4 Continents and more than 3000 participants.
- Matches played on 12 grass/artificial grass fields in the Rimini Riviera and San Marino Republic.

Touristic information:

- Rimini, bordering on the northern part of Riccione, is the largest seaside resort on the Adriatic coast. The city shows two different faces. The old center, west of the railroad, with its roman and medieval monuments. On the other side of the railroad is the attractive new city with about 15 kilometres beautiful beaches, numerous hotels, restaurants, shopping centers and a promenade with all one may expect in a topper of sun tourism. In Rimini, there are a lot of attractions such as the "Delfinario" (dolphin shows) and Fabilandia (amusement park).
- San Marino is a miniature state in the foothills of the Apennines. It is famous for its spectacular position on top of a bare rock (Monte Titano), where you already can see from a long distance the three castles, dominating the "capital". The center of San Marino, of which you can have breath-taking views on the surroundings, is especially attractive because of its small alleys with numerous shops, taverns and pizzerias/restaurants.
- Mirabilandia: An Italian amusement park, located in Savio, frazione of Ravenna, which is located in Emilia-Romagna. With a total area of 850,000 square meters, it is the biggest Park of Italy. Admission fee approx. Euro 14.00 per person.
- Italia in Miniatura (Rimini). An unforgettable itinerary through more than 270 architectural and scenic wonders, in a lively, evocative scenario. Perfect 1:25 and 1:40 scale replicas of monuments, ancient castles, famous piazzas, mountains, seas and lakes. From ancient times to the present day.
