ITINERARY SPRING/SUMMER, 2026

- Day 1 Departure from Miami airport.
- Day 2 Arrival Rio de Janeiro airport. Transfer to your accommodation. Afternoon at leisure to explore the area around your hotel.
- Day 3 Excursion Rio de Janeiro – Visit the Christ the Redeemer Sanctuary, located in the heart of Rio de Janeiro, is the world's first open-air sanctuary, a sacred space welcoming people of all cultures, beliefs, and backgrounds. Evening game vs. a local team.
- Day 4 Morning pro training session with coaching staff of Fluminense. In the afternoon, enjoy the views from Morro da Urca and Sugarloaf Mountain. Located on a small peninsula, the Urca neighborhood left a really positive impression on many of our groups. Another option is to visit Serra Orgãos National Park with its famous peak Dedo de Deus (Finger of God). Evening visit pro soccer game in the famous Maracanã Stadium.
- Day 5 Visit the famous Copacabana Beach and/or Ipanema Beach. While there are dozens of beaches to choose from, the most famous ones are Copacabana and Ipanema. It would be a good idea to visit at least one of them to get the authentic Rio beach experience. Evening game vs. a local team.
- Day 6 Transfer to your accommodation in Búzios.



- Day 7 City tour of Búzios. Búzios, once a small fisherman's village, is now a very charming place with ateliers, pousadas, sophisticated cafés and rustic restaurants.
- Day 8 Sailing boat tour around the beaches and islands of Búzios. Evening game vs. a local team.
- Day 9 Motor coach transfer to Rio de Janeiro Airport. Return flight. Time permitting, on the way stop at Rio Sul shopping mall in Rio for shopping.
- Day 10 Arrival back in the USA.

- The hotel has a restaurant, bar, lounge and reception.
- Accommodation in rooms for 2 and 3 people (3 twin beds or a double bed and twin bed typically) and all rooms have a private bathroom, TV, phone, Wi-Fi access, and air conditioning. Double rooms (2 people per room) are available at a supplement of \$15.00 per person per night and single rooms (1 person per room) are available at a supplement of \$55.00 per person per night

3-star Hotel accommodation in Buzios.

- Daily breakfast included as well as a farewell dinner.
- All rooms for 2 and 3 people have private shower, toilet and TV.
- The hotel has a lounge, restaurant and lounge.




GROUND TRANSPORTATION INCLUDED:

SIGHTSEEING IN Rio de Janeiro and Buzios

CHRIST THE REDEEMER

Visit the Christ the Redeemer Sanctuary, located in the heart of Rio de Janeiro, is the world's first open-air sanctuary, a sacred space welcoming people of all cultures, beliefs, and backgrounds. The colossal Christ the Redeemer monument on top of Corcovado Mountain is the landmark of Rio de Janeiro and the most-visited tourist attraction in the city. In order to reach the statue, you can either take a van or a tram, or hike through Tijuca Forest National Park up the steep slopes of Corcovado. The hike is apparently quite challenging, and it takes around 2 hours to reach the summit.

SUGARLOAF MOUNTAIN

Located on a small peninsula, the Urca neighborhood left a really positive impression on me. It had a totally different vibe from the rest of the areas I visited in the city. It felt relaxed and quiet, like a laid-back suburb, far away from the hustle and bustle of the city whereas in reality, it's just a stone's throw away from Copacabana. Without skyscrapers, traffic jams and swarms of people, it seemed as if life runs at a different pace in Urca.

DEDO DE DEUS – FINGER OF GOD

Visit Serra Orgãos National Park with its famous peak Dedo de Deus (Finger of God). Dedo de Deus, also known as God's Finger Peak, is a 1,692-meter (5,551-foot) granite peak located in the Serra dos Órgãos National Park in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. It is one of the most popular hiking and climbing destinations in the park, and its distinctive finger-shaped formation is visible from much of the surrounding area. The peak is named after its resemblance to a giant hand with an extended index finger pointing towards the sky.

COPACABANA AND IPANEMA BEACHES

Visit the famous Copacabana Beach and/or Ipanema Beach. While there are dozens of beaches to choose from, the most famous ones are Copacabana and Ipanema. It would be a good idea to visit at least one of them to get the authentic Rio beach experience. At the beach, rent a chair and maybe a parasol, bury your toes in the soft white sand and you're all set for the perfect lazy day. Here, various vendors will try to sell you everything from bikinis, beach sarongs and jewelry to chips, fruit and grilled cheese. You can also order ice-cold fresh coconuts, beers or delicious fruity caipirinhas which are delivered to you from beachside kiosks called *barracas*. All of this without even having to stand up from your chair!

CITY TOUR OF BUZIOS

Armação dos Búzios (or Búzios) is a Brazilian resort set on an ocean peninsula east of Rio de Janeiro. It's known as an upscale vacation destination with numerous beaches. These include Ferradura, on a calm horseshoe bay with water sports, and Geribá, a popular surfing site. Among its village streets, the cobbled Rua das Pedras is a center of dining and nightlife.

SAILING BOAT TOUR BUZIOS

Experience the beauty of Buzios as it's meant to be seen, by boat, on this catamaran cruise. Board your vessel and spend your time swimming and snorkelling in the crystal clear waters. Your skipper makes several stops along the way to get the full experience of the charming coastal area. Observe local marine life as you swim in the water. Enjoy views of white-sand beaches from the boat.
