Travel dates:

July 10-24, 2022

Itinerary:

- July 10 Departure from San Francisco airport.
- July 11 Arrival Copenhagen or Aalborg airport. Transfer to your accommodation in Frederikshavn for Cup No. 1. Evening opening ceremony.
- July 12 Start of the tournament. First round group matches.
- July 13 First ground group matches continue. Evening: disco and team coach's reception.
- July 14 Second round/play-off matches. Evening: disco.
- July 15 Second round/play-off matches. Evening: fireworks display.
- July 16 Tournament finals.
- July 17 Transfer to Frederikshavn harbor and ferry crossing to Gothenburg. Transfer to your accommodation for the Gothia Cup.
- July 18 Start group matches Gothia Cup
Evening opening ceremony in the Ullevi stadium.
- July 19 Group matches.
Evening team leader reception.
- July 20 Group matches.
Evening team leader matches.
- July 21 Playoff matches.
- July 22 Playoff matches.
Evening team leader match.
- July 23 Gothia Cup finals in the Ullevi Stadium.
- July 24 Transfer to Gothenburg or Copenhagen airport and return flight.

Sport program included:

Denmark: Participation in Cup No. 1.

Sweden: Participation in the Gothia Cup.

Accommodation and meals included:

Denmark: Accommodation in schools in Frederikshavn.

- Daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included. First meal is dinner July 11th and last meal is dinner July 15th.
- Each team will receive one classroom for its own use. Cup No. 1 will arrange bedding for all participants. Bedding includes a mattress, blanket, pillow and linen. Schools have shared facilities and bathrooms by gender.

Sweden: School accommodation in schools in Gothenburg.

- Daily breakfast, lunch and dinner included. First meal: Evening dinner Sunday, July 17, and last meal lunch on Saturday, July 23.
- Each team will receive one classroom for its own use. The Gothia Cup will arrange bedding for all participants. Bedding includes a mattress on the floor with pillow, sheets and a duvet/blanket. Schools have shared facilities and bathrooms by gender.



Ground transportation included:

Airport transfers and the transfer from Cup No. 1 to the Gothia Cup are included. During the Cup No. 1 the tournament organizers arrange special shuttle transportation to and from the fields. On free days we can arrange a private chartered bus for excursions (for an additional charge).

Local guide services included:

During your stay at both tournaments, you can collect information or address any questions or concerns with the local tournament staff, which is readily available.



Options available (not included in prices)

Accommodation option Cup No. 1:

Hotel accommodation in a nice 3 or 4 star hotel in the center of Frederikshavn in rooms for 4 people to a room. Rooms usually have 2 twin/single beds and one bunk bed. Daily breakfast is included. Front desk, bar, lounge, restaurant and indoor pool. All 4 bedded rooms are equipped with a private bathroom with bathtub and/or shower, equipped with a hairdryer, wireless internet access, TV, desk and a chair. Single, double and triple rooms are available as well. Supplemental cost for a room with 4 people is \$70.00 per person per night. Supplemental cost for a room with 3 people is \$78.00 per person

per night. Supplemental cost for 2 people per room is \$137.00 per person per night. Supplemental cost for a single room (1 person) is \$263.00 per person per night.

Accommodation options Gothia Cup:

Option 1: Hotel accommodation in a nice hotel in Moeldal, 5-10 minutes from Gothenburg.

- Rooms for 2-4 people all with private bathroom, TV, mini bar, telephone, data port, trouser/skirt press and ironing board and iron. The hotel has a lounge, bar, conference rooms and a fitness center with Jacuzzi and sauna.
- Supplement per person per night sharing a quadruple room \$13.00. Supplement per person per night sharing a triple room \$19.00. Supplement per person per night sharing a double room \$45.00.

Option 2: Hotel accommodation at the Gothia Towers, a 4-star hotel in the center of Gothenburg.

- Double and triple rooms all with private bathroom, TV, telephone, parquet floor, mini bar, iron, trouser press, a kettle for tea and coffee and a safe deposit box. The hotel has a lounge, bar and various restaurants.
- Supplement per person per night sharing a triple room \$30.00. Supplement per person per night sharing a double room \$55.00.

Both hotel options include only breakfast daily. The Gothia Cup offers a meal plan as well; self-service, cafeteria type meals served at the tournament center. Costs are approx. \$120.00 per person for 12 meals and \$65.00 per person for 6 meals (lunch or dinner).

Please notice that we can guarantee the hotel names only when the entire group books a hotel stay. If your team stays at a school, parents will be accommodated in similar hotels but not necessarily in these specific hotels. In addition, if parents stay at hotels and players/coaches at the school, airport transfers are only included for the players/coaches. Parents can take a taxi from the airport to their hotel.

Travel insurance option:

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including a Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.

Not included in prices:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions.
- Single rooms in hotels. Single rooms are available at a supplement of \$40.00 per person per night on top of the double room supplements outlined in the accommodation description.

Tournament Information

CUP NO. 1 - FREDERIKSHAVN/DENMARK

The name is new; however, the tournament has been held in Frederikshavn since 1984 in the name of Dana Cup No. 1. In Cup No.1 all matches will be played on fine grass football fields in Frederikshavn. The participants will be able to walk around town between fields, accommodation and feeding. This gives you, as a club, a lot of time together and you will very much sense the international atmosphere. Since 1984 almost 7,000 teams from 92 nations have visited the tournament in Frederikshavn, which is situated in the heart of Scandinavia. Normally about 250 teams from 20 nations have entered the tournament. In the past edition, among others, teams from Brazil, Kenya, India, El Salvador, Honduras, Peru, the USA, Russia, Zambia and Portugal participated.



Cup No. 1 facts:

- 250+ international youth soccer teams.
- 20+ countries represented.
- Games will take place on natural grass fields in the same area so your team/s do not have to spend a lot of time on transportation.

Touristic information:

- Beaches: many miles of excellent sandy beaches on the North Sea coast near Hirtshals, approx. 15 kms from Hjørring.
- North Sea Oceanarium: situated in Hirtshals. This center also has Europe's largest sea-aquarium. Furthermore, there is a sea-lion basin and a Maritime-, a fishing- and a sea-biological museum.
- Frederikshavn: (36,000 inhabitants). One of Denmark's most important ferry-ports and marine base. There are various museums and from here Gothenburg/Sweden can be reached for a day-trip using one of the most modern ferry-vessels in the world. Cruising at approx. 70 kms per hours the journey can be covered in about 2 hrs.
- Visit Fårup Sommerland, one of Denmark's biggest amusement parks.

The opening ceremony at Ullevi Stadium attracts 50,000 spectators and participants, while 1,500 volunteers guarantee that this will remain the tournament of all tournaments! First-class competition on first-class fields is only part of this great festive week. Located on Sweden's beautiful west coast, Gothenburg offers all the excitement of a major seaport city, as well as fine beaches, water sports, boat trips, shopping and dining. The 2022 Gothia Cup will again be the world's largest and most prestigious soccer party for both players and fans.



Gothia Cup facts:

- 1,600+ international youth soccer teams
- 40,000 participants from 80 different countries
- One of the highlights of the tournament is the Olympic style opening ceremony which takes place in Ullevi Stadium, home stadium of Swedish pro club IFK Göteborg, with 50,000+ spectators.
- Games will take place on natural grass and turf fields at approx. 30 soccer complexes.
- Heden is the heart of Gothia Cup. Here you will find the Central Information building, the tournament's headquarters during the week.

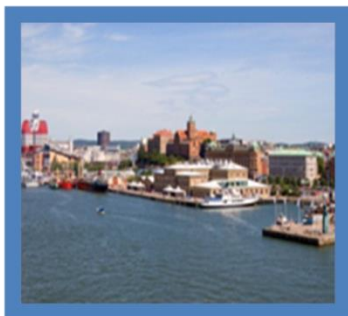
Touristic information:
