Argentina – Buenos Aires

Travel dates:

Mid-July – Early August, 2025 (Exact Dates TBD.)

Itinerary:

- Day 1 Departure from New York City airport.
- Day 2 Arrival Buenos Aires Airport. Transfer to your accommodation. After check-in, we'll offer the group a walking tour to explore the area around your hotel as well as a light training session.
- Day 3 Guided bus tour of Buenos Aires. Located in a relatively compact area near the old colonial heart of the city, the Plaza de Mayo was established in 1580, the main sites include the Pink, Colon Theater, Government Palace, and the world's widest avenue – la 9 de Julio – with its Obelisco monument. Late afternoon optional community service project. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Day 4 Day trip to La Boca. The city's historical Little Italy where El Caminito, a historical pedestrian zone is located. Afternoon visit the Boca Juniors Football Stadium as well as the museum, popularly known as La Bombonera (the Chocolate Box). From the outside, the stadium seems to be part of the scale model exhibited in the museum depicting this famous neighborhood. Everything is intertwined and indivisible: not only is La Bombonera a part of a neighborhood that witnessed its creation, but it also defines its identity. It was in this port suburb that football and Argentina were born. For the evening, we recommend attending a Tango Show (the extra cost for this Tango show is approx. \$100.00 per person and it includes dinner, wine, tango class, and the show); the dance originated in lower-class districts of Buenos Aires and the music was derived from the fusion of various forms of music from Europe. The first association of Tango with its distinctive music and dance is recorded circa 1890s.
- Day 5 Morning walking tour to Calle Florida and La Galleria Pacifico: shopping at Calle Florida with live performing artists in the streets, later time for shopping at Galerías Pacifico Artistic Mall. Shopping areas in Buenos Aires are the best places for people-watching and traditional crafts and food. Afternoon community service project. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Day 6 Pro Soccer Club Experience Day at a Buenos Aires area pro club. Start in the morning by watching a training session of the first team (if available) with a possible introduction from a player from the first team. After this, tour the stadium, the club museum, and the locker room followed by lunch at the Academy complex and then a training session with a club coach.



- Day 7 Walking tour to the beautiful Recoleta Neighborhood, known for its squares, parks, cafés and galleries. You may also visit the astonishing Recoleta cemetery where the famous Eva Duarte de Peron, most known as “Evita” is buried. Eva was deemed “Spiritual Leader of the Nation” and was a major contributor to women’s and low-income rights in Argentina. She was a former actress and married Juan Peron who became president, which is where much of her influence began.
Another option for this day is to spend a day in Buenos Aires to explore the city, do your shopping, etc. This option is included in the tour costs. A very nice option is a walking tour of the San Telmo Neighborhood. This is a cool, colonial district with a beautiful antique fair market. You may see performing street artists dancing tango, music bands, etc. During the weekend it is very lively and crowded. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Day 8 Morning available to do your final shopping. Afternoon transfer to Buenos Aires Airport and return flight.
- Day 9 Return home.

Sport program included:

We will arrange 3 games. After the games meals/snacks with opposition will be provided. We will also include a Club Day with either Boca Juniors, River Plate, San Lorenzo, Racing, or Independiente which includes a training session with a club coach and a tour of their stadium.

Accommodation and meals included:

Three-star hotel accommodation - daily breakfast and dinner is included. The hotel is centrally located in Buenos Aires, close to several tourist places such as the Plaza de Mayo, and there are also several Metro stations in the surrounding area. Includes accommodation in double rooms for 2 people per room with a private bathroom, free Wi-Fi, cable TV, and minibar. The hotel offers its own restaurant and bar/lounge. Single rooms (1 person per room) are available at a supplement of \$55.00 per person per night.

Ground transportation included:

We have included all mentioned transportation as well as airport transfers. Many of the tours we offer are walking tours.

Local guide services included:

A local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time each day during your stay in each destination to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

Touristic information Buenos Aires

Buenos Aires is the capital and most populous city of Argentina. The city is located on the western shore of the estuary of the Río de la Plata, on the South American continent's southeastern coast. Buenos Aires is a top tourist destination and is known for its preserved Spanish/European-style architecture and rich cultural life – it is known as the “Paris of South America”. Buenos Aires held the 1st Pan American Games in 1951 as well as hosting two venues in the 1978 FIFA World Cup. Buenos Aires will host the 2018 Summer Youth Olympics and the 2018 G20 summit. The tango is the national dance of Argentina which originated in the 1880s along the River Plate, the natural border between Argentina and Uruguay, and soon spread to the rest of the world.

Puerto Madero: When visitors want to take an evening stroll, many head to Puerto Madero, where dazzling city lights illuminate the port that once served as a major destination for European trade. During the day, this area rests as a quiet business hub, but by night, this little neighborhood bursts with energy. Trendy porteños flock to the neighborhood steak and seafood restaurants and tango at festive dance clubs. Standout spots include Rojo Tango and Asia de Cuba, which are both for their sultry dancing and festive décor.

La Boca: This fashionable neighborhood located in southern Buenos Aires brims with trendy boutiques and art galleries. Once a gritty shipyard bustling with European immigrants, this now vibrant port houses local artists, soccer fans, and middle-class workers alike. Its name—which translates to “The Mouth”—is derived from its distinct location near the Río de la Plata (the estuary formed by the meeting of the Uruguay and Paraná rivers). Make your way to Vuelta de Rocha's triangular plaza and you'll come upon the start of colorful Caminito, a popular pedestrian sidewalk flanked by bright murals and shimmering metal houses. Here, you'll also find the taxicab-yellow stadium of Argentina's most popular soccer team, Boca Juniors, along with lively cafés, bars, and casual tango institutions.

Recoleta Cemetery: This beloved cemetery—located in the ritzy Recoleta neighborhood—is the resting place of many notable political figures and elites in Argentine history. You'll probably recall Madonna belting out Tim Rice's lyrics “Don't Cry for Me Argentina” in her rendition as Eva “Evita” Perón in the 1978 musical, *Evita*. But what you may not remember is Eva Perón's role as the outspoken and influential First Lady of Argentina in 1946, nor her untimely death at age 33 from cancer. As you stroll through the cemetery, you'll not only catch a glimpse of Ms. Perón's ornate resting place, but also discover a wide array of art nouveau, art deco, and modernist mausoleums. Another highlight is the towering Círculo Militar, a black structure imported from Paris that features stunning white marble angels. One TripAdvisor user comments, “It is a necropolis full of architectural art. A visit to the city wouldn't be complete without this.”

Trinidad and Tobago – Port of Spain

Travel dates:

Mid-July – Early August, 2025 (Exact Dates TBD.)

Itinerary:

- Day 1 Departure from New York City airport. Arrival Port-of-Spain airport and transfer to your accommodation.
- Day 2 Optional morning training session with your own coaching staff and after that visit Queen's Park Savannah, the largest traffic roundabout in the world, and the historical Magnificent Seven. Evening pan yard visit with lesson - how to play a steel pan.
- Day 3 Visit Maracas Beach, a beautiful beach located on the north side of the island.
- Day 4 Morning training and after that picturesque hike to Maracas Waterfalls, the highest waterfalls in Trinidad. **Evening game vs. local team.**
- Day 5 Optional day trip by flight to Tobago. Another option for today can be to either visit the Pitch Lake or go down the Islands with a chartered boat and visit the Gasparee Caves which includes swimming in a real bat cave. **Evening game vs. local team.**
- Day 6 Optional zip-lining excursion in Chaguaramas and afternoon community service project; soccer clinic and education for underprivileged school children in Trinidad.
- Day 7 Take a swamp tour through the lagoons and rivers to see all the wildlife in Trinidad. **Evening game vs. local team.**
- Day 8 Transfer to Port-of-Spain Airport for return flight back home.

Sport program:

We will arrange 3 games per team.

Accommodation and meals included:

Accommodation in the 4-star plus Hilton Hotel in Port of Spain right across the street from the Queen's Park Savannah and within minutes of downtown Port of Spain by bus/car.

- Daily breakfast and dinner included.
- Accommodation in rooms with 2 double/full size beds for 3 or 4 people per room. Rooms have private bathroom and shower and rooms are equipped with A/C, cable TV, phone, WI-FI internet access, a safe, ironing board and hairdryer.

- Visit Maracas Beach with local Bake 'n Shark – additional costs approx. \$5.00 per person.
- Hike to Maracas Waterfalls - additional costs will be approx. \$ 10.00 per person to have your own private guide available for this hike.
- Optional day trip by flight to Tobago. Tobago is the smaller of the two main islands that make up the Republic of Trinidad & Tobago. It's located in the southern Caribbean, northeast of the island of Trinidad and southeast of Grenada. The additional cost for this day trip is \$135.00 per person.
- Zip Lining in Chaguaramas; the zip lines are the best way to get a bird's eye view of the breathtaking beauty at Macqueripe Bay, Chaguaramas. Zip line tour approx. \$15.00 per person.
- The Pitch Lake, nature's own wonder, is located on Trinidad's south-western coast. We invite you to soak in natural Sulphur pools, enjoy the bountiful bird life, or just stand inspired by one of nature's true wonders. The Pitch Lake holds approximately 10 million tons of asphalt. It is the world's largest commercial deposit of natural asphalt, which is mined and exported for use in manufacturing and road paving. You could well imagine the Pitch Lake is alive. It burps. It hisses. The cost for this excursion is \$15.00 per person.
- Swamp tour - \$10.00 per person. Experience the natural beauty and wildlife of Trinidad on this excursion. Head to the country's largest mangrove, Caroni Swamp, and navigate its maze-like waterways in a traditional local boat. Watch for birds, mammals, and reptiles, and search among the wetlands for Caroni's national bird, the scarlet ibis.
- The Paramin Experience: We offer tours of Paramin which allow locals and foreign nationals to experience the adventurous nature and thrills of the hills in Paramin. Tours include a 4x4 experience in Paramin traditional off-road Toyota Land Cruisers. On these tours, we visit various places such as The Mya Spring and waterfall, The Paramin Caves, Paragrant bay and waterfall, agricultural farms, nature trails and landmarks such as La Vigie Paramin Lookout. We also provide quality agricultural produce and green seasoning from the hills of Paramin. The cost for this excursion is \$60.00 per person.

Community service option:

We can have your team perform a community service project with a soccer clinic and education day for underprivileged school children in Trinidad.

Travel dates:

Mid-July – Early August, 2025 (Exact Dates TBD.)

Itinerary:

- Day 1 Departure from New York City airport.
- Day 2 Arrival Barcelona airport. Transfer to your accommodation.
- Day 3 Bus or boat tour Tossa de Mar: visit the beautiful old fishing town made famous in the 1950s by Ava Gardner and James Mason in the film Pandora and the Flying Dutchman. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Day 4 Visit Barcelona by bus, covering the Bullring, the Gaudi buildings, Casa Batlló and the Pedrera, Plaza Francesc Masia, the Nou Camp - home of FC Barcelona, followed by Gaudi's unfinished Sagrada Familia Cathedral, and lastly Parque Guell.
- Day 5 Visit the city of Girona. Sightseeing possibilities include St. Mary's Cathedral, built between the 11th and 17th centuries, Passeig de la Muralla, Monastery of Saint Pere de Galligants and Chapel of Sant Nicolau, the Arab Baths, Cases de l'Onyar, etc. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Day 6 Visit the sacred mountain-top monastery of Montserrat with its breathtaking views.
- Day 7 Free day in Barcelona visiting the places the bus cannot reach. Drop off and pick up point in the central Plaza Catalunya. Recommended are the: Ramblas with its human statues and street artists, Palau de la Musica, Barrio Gotico with its maze of narrow streets, Plaza Real, and Cathedral. **Evening game vs. a local team.**
- Day 8 More sightseeing in Barcelona. Visit Montjuic, a prominent hill overlooking Barcelona with amazing views of the city and home to the Olympic facilities.
- Day 9 Transfer to Barcelona airport and return flight.

SIGHTSEEING IN BARCELONA

Recommended excursion(s) to pre-book are Nou Camp and Sagrada Familia.

1) **CAMP NOU (Stadium under construction, museum only)**

Price: ADULTS \$42.00 (Under 13's + Students \$33.00)

Visit the Home of Barcelona FC: the away team changing room, the players' tunnel, the dugouts, the press room, the commentators' box, and of course, the Museum. The Museum is the most modern football museum thanks to its interactive wall spaces, large-scale audiovisual displays, and an extensive display of objects to explain the history of FC Barcelona and understand the values that make Barça "més que un club" - "more than a club".

2) **SAGRADA FAMÍLIA**

Price: \$44.00 pp Fully Guided Group Tour (Includes a Tour Guide) – Does not include towers

The unfinished Cathedral by Gaudí, the expiatory church of La Sagrada Família, is a work on a grand scale that began on March 19, 1882, from a project by the diocesan architect, Francisco de Paula del Villar (1828-1901). At the end of 1883, Gaudí was commissioned to continue the work, a task which he did not abandon until his death in 1926. Since then, different architects have continued the work after his original idea.

Important note: Once your group decides to pre-book this excursion, we do require an official letter from your club, school, or university. Please feel free to ask for a sample letter from us. Secondly, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to get admission tickets for this site.

3) **MONTSERRAT MOUNTAINS**

Price: Rack Railway Return Prices: Adult \$17.00 (Under 13s \$10.00), Santa Cova Funicular Return Prices: Adult \$15.00 (Child \$5.00) and Sant Joan Funicular Return Prices: Adult \$9.00 (Child \$9.00). Pre-booking is not available. Montserrat is a multi-peak mountain located near the city of Barcelona. It is well known as the site of the Benedictine abbey, Santa Maria de Montserrat, which hosts the Virgin of Montserrat sanctuary, which is identified by some with the location of the Holy Grail in Arthurian myth. The mountain is composed of a strikingly pink conglomerate, a form of sedimentary rock, and Montserrat is Spain's first National Park.

4) **LA RAMBLA & BOQUERIA MARKET**

Prices: Free

This busy street is just for pedestrians and is lined with outdoor markets, shops, restaurants, and cafes. La Boqueria is a large public market in the Ciutat Vella district of Barcelona, and one of the city's foremost tourist landmarks, with an entrance from La Rambla, near the Liceu, Barcelona's opera house. The market has a remarkably diverse selection of goods.
