

## International Soccer Tour 2024 Itinerary San Antonio Athletic FC Denmark– Copenhagen and Dana Cup

### Travel dates:

July 19-28, 2024

### Itinerary:

- July 19 Departure from San Antonio airport.
- July 20 Arrival Copenhagen airport. After arrival transfer to accommodation.
- July 21 Sightseeing Copenhagen.
- July 22 Transfer to Dana Cup Accommodation in Hirtshals. Evening parade into Hjørring Stadium, official opening ceremony and Dana Cup disco.
- July 23 Start of tournament with group matches. Leisure time option: visit Skagen and see Grenen Beach where the Baltic and North Seas converge.  
Evening: Dana Cup team managers and coaches meeting.
- July 24 First round group matches. Leisure time option: visit Hirtshals and see the Hirtshals Fyr lighthouse and the Tornby Stand beach.  
Evening: Dana Cup disco.
- July 25 Second round play-off matches. Leisure time option: visit Hirtshals and see the North Sea Oceanarium.  
Evening: Dana Cup disco.
- July 26 Second round play-off matches. Leisure time option: visit Blokhus and the Fårup Sommerland amusement park.  
Evening: Dana Cup disco.
- July 27 Second round play-off matches and finals. Leisure time option: Take the train to Aalborg.
- July 28 Transfer to Copenhagen, Aalborg, or Billund airport and return flight.

**Sport program included:**

**Denmark:** Participation in the Dana Cup.

**Accommodation and meals:**

**Copenhagen:** Hotel/Bed and breakfast – daily breakfast included.

Accommodation in a 3-star hotel located in Copenhagen. The hotel is located approx. 5 kilometers from the airport and 4 kilometers to the main train station and center of town. Rooms for 3 and 4 people all with private bathroom. Double rooms available as well at a supplement of \$20.00 per person per night.

**Option #1 -**

**Hjørring: Option 1:** Hotel/Bed and breakfast – daily breakfast included.

Accommodation in a 4-star hotel located in Hirtshals. This includes accommodation in rooms with private bathrooms, satellite TV, phone, Wi-Fi access, desk and electric kettle. Facilities of the hotel include a reception area, lounge and restaurant. Daily breakfast included. Participant prices are based on 3 or 4 people sharing a room. Supplement per person per night is \$68.00 sharing a room for 2 people or \$144.00 per night for a single room.

**Hjørring: Option 2:** Apartment Accommodation/No meals included.

The Dana Cup offers accommodation in apartments as well. This apartment complex is in Hirtshals, directly at the beach and 8 miles from Hjørring. All apartments have a living room, kitchen and one, two or three bedrooms. The complex offers a lounge, restaurant, indoor and outdoor swimming pool, table tennis, sauna, solarium, laundry room, free Wi-Fi, etc. We have based the calculation on 5-6 per apartment. Supplement per person per stay \$140.00 for 4 people sharing an apartment and supplement per person per stay \$491.00 for 2 people sharing an apartment.

You can order meal cards through the Dana Cup. All meals will be served at the main tournament cafeteria. Costs \$140.00 for a meal package; 3 meals a day from Monday dinner until Saturday lunch. On case of lunches and dinners the extra costs will be \$ 114.00 total.

(These prices always include the special Dana Cup package including the special Dana Cup shuttle transportation (accommodation to fields and vice versa), free admission to the Hjørring swimming pool, Hjørring museums and Dana Cup disco as well as discounted admission at Farup Summerland and the North Sea Museum).

**Ground transportation included:**

During the Dana Cup the tournament organizers arrange special shuttle transportation. On free days we can arrange a private chartered bus for excursions (for an additional charge). During your stay in Copenhagen a private bus will be available. Bus drivers can drive a maximum of 100km per day.

**Local guide services included:**

During your stay at the Dana Cup, you can collect information or address any questions or concerns with the local tournament staff, which is readily available. During your stay in Copenhagen a local bi-lingual tour manager will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full time to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

**Options available (not included in prices) - Travel insurance option:**

Your participants have the option to purchase accident, illness, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance, including a Cancel for Any Reason Coverage (CFAR) – more information about this insurance is included on your team website page.

**Not included in prices:**

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions.

## Tournament Information

### DANA CUP - HJØRRING/DENMARK

Come and meet the rest of the world at the Dana Cup 2024, the World's most international youth soccer tournament with 90% foreign teams. More than 1,000 teams from 45 nations each summer. They come to play international soccer, but also because of the fantastic international atmosphere. The Dana Cup is a sporting challenge mixed with a cultural experience where young soccer players regardless of borders, skin color, politics and religion can meet in a safe environment. Each year the tournament is proud to welcome the rest of the soccer world to Hjørring



#### Dana Cup facts:

- 1,000+ international youth soccer teams.
- Over 45 different countries represented.
- Tournament co-organized by Fortuna Hjørring, one of the top professional clubs in Denmark.

#### Touristic information:

- **Beaches:** many miles of excellent sandy beaches on the North Sea coast near Hirtshals, approx. 15 kms from Hjørring.
- **North Sea Oceanarium:** situated in Hirtshals. This centre also has Europe's largest sea-aquarium. Furthermore, there is a sea-lion basin and a Maritime-, a fishing- and a sea-biological museum.
- **Frederikshavn:** (36,000 inhabitants). One of Denmark's most important ferries-ports and marine base. There are various museums and from here Gothenburg/Sweden can be reached for a day-trip using one of the most modern ferries-vessels in the world. Cruising at approx. 70 kms per hours the journey can be covered in about 2 hrs.

## SIGHTSEEING IN COPENHAGEN AND SURROUNDINGS 2024

### 1) **THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF DENMARK**

The entire history of Denmark comes to life at the National Museum. Experience the treasures the Vikings brought back home from distant shores of the World. You can also hear the stories of the people who stayed back home in Denmark and experience the Vikings' everyday life when they did not engage in voyages or warfare. The children can play in the Children's Museum or find and press the Boredom Buttons that enable animals to talk, mummies to mysteriously move and exhibitions to catch fire out of the blue.

### 2) **TIVOLI GARDENS**

More than two dozen rides await you at this world-class amusement park that inspired Walt Disney. Tivoli Gardens, in the very center of Copenhagen, is well-known for its old-world charm, lush gardens, and rides for all ages. You'll get to watch live concerts and light shows, as well as see the fireworks that take place every week. When hungry, choose between the wide selection of restaurants and food stands, or have a picnic in the gardens.

### 3) **NYHAVN**

Copenhagen's Nyhavn, or "New Harbor," is steeped in a long heritage. Colorful buildings line the canal and hint at the history of small-vessel traffic. Like many ports, this strip has a salty history, rich with sailors and literary exploits. Danish author Hans Christian Andersen made his home in Nyhavn as well. It's cleaned up now and is a lovely place for a stroll.

### 4) **COPENHAGEN CANAL TOUR**

Experience the beauty and history of Copenhagen on a canal tour! Learn about the beautiful and historic landmarks and all other sights of interest. This boat sightseeing tour departs from Nyhavn or Ved Stranden and passes some of Copenhagen's best sights and attractions.

5) **ROSENBERG CASTLE**

The beautiful 400-year-old castle is situated in central Copenhagen's popular park, The King's Garden. The castle was built by one of the most famous Scandinavian kings, Christian IV. Today, the glory of the past can be experienced through the numerous art treasures of the previous kings and queens. Among the main attractions is the Great Hall with the coronation thrones and three life-size silver lions standing guard. The crown jewels and royal regalia sparkle behind the thick walls of the treasury beneath the castle.
