

ITINERARY MARCH 27-APRIL 4, 2026

- Mar. 27 Departure from Detroit airport.
- Mar. 28 Arrival Paris airport. Transfer to your accommodation. Afternoon or evening possible visit to a pro game.
- Mar. 29 Sightseeing Paris. Options include the Champs-Élysées, Arc de Triomphe (with the option to climb the stairs to the top), the Eiffel Tower, and the Louvre. Afternoon or evening possible visit to a pro game.

Afternoon or evening game vs. a local team.

- Mar. 30 Afternoon: sightseeing, suggestion: visit to Paris Montmartre/Place du Tertre. Situated in the very heart of Montmartre, one of the most famous squares in all of Paris is that of Place du Tertre, which is world-famous for its painters, cafés, and ambiance. Only a few streets away from Montmartre's Basilica of the Sacré Cœur and the Lapin Agile, it is near the summit of the city's elevated Montmartre quarter. At an altitude of 130 meters, the Place du Tertre is the highest square in Paris. All over the square, various artists set up their easels in the afternoon, tempting the visitors with their works of art: personalized charcoal portraits, water paintings, drawings, sculptures, etc.
- Mar. 31 Visit Versailles, France's most magnificent chateau, 13 miles (20 km) southwest of Paris.

 Afternoon or evening game vs. a local team.



- April 1 Morning or afternoon training session with a youth pro club coach from a Paris area pro club. More sightseeing in Paris. Options include Notre Dame Cathedral, Place de la Concorde, and The Quartier Latin (Latin Quarter).
- April 2 Morning optional training session with your own coaching staff. Optional stadium tour of Parc des Princes, home of pro club Paris St. Germain. After that explore the Saint-Germain-des-Prés neighborhood which has a village feel, and a mix of culture and heritage, right in the heart of Paris.
- April 3 Day at leisure for more sightseeing in Paris. Do some shopping in Le Marais, known for its boutiques and vintage stores and/or visit the Paris Catacombs, underground ossuaries in Paris, France, which hold the remains of more than six million people. Afternoon or evening game vs. a local team.
- April 4 Transfer to Paris airport. Return flight.
- * The above itinerary is a provisional/suggested itinerary and can/will change depending on your group's specific wishes, the final game schedule for your team(s) and any pro game visit(s) incorporated for your group. Sightseeing admission fees are not included in the prices but can be added and prebooked based on your group's specific wishes. Consult us for more information.

ROUND TRIP AIRFARE INCLUDED

Round trip airfare, including airport taxes and fuel surcharges. Prices are always subject to

availability of flights and fares at the time of tour booking.



We will arrange 3 games per team. We will also arrange a training session per team with a youth coach from a Paris area pro club.



ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS INCLUDED:

Paris: 4-star hotel accommodation in the Paris area.

- Daily breakfast and dinner are included.
- Hotel located in the Paris area approx. 16 miles from the city center.
- All triple rooms (2 single beds + 1 sofa bed) with private bathroom, satellite TV, phone, and air-conditioning. Double rooms are available as well at a supplement of \$20.00 per person per night and single rooms are available at a supplement of \$60.00 per person per night.
- The hotel has a restaurant, lounge/bar, reception area and Wi-Fi.



GROUND TRANSPORTATION INCLUDED:

During your entire stay, a private bus will be available exclusively for your group –

10 hours a day.



LOCAL GUIDE SERVICES INCLUDED:

A local tour assistant will be assigned to be exclusively with your group full-time each day

during your stay in each destination to provide you with any assistance when necessary and help plan or amend your daily schedule as needed.

NOT INCLUDED ARE:

- Beverages (soda) with meals.
- Gratuities for representatives and bus drivers.
- Admission fees to attractions.



SPORT PROGRAM OPTIONS

- We can arrange additional training sessions with youth academy coaches from French pro clubs or the French Soccer Federation. Supplement for a 2-hour session, including field hire, is approx. \$1,200 total.
- We can arrange tickets for pro games, subject to availability. Ticket costs will depend on the game, but usually, ticket costs range from approx. \$75.00-\$150.00 or more per person depending on the game.
- Visit and tour of a pro team stadium between \$30.00 and \$40.00 per person.

SIGHTSEEING IN PARIS

AND SURROUNDINGS

LE LOUVRE MUSEUM

Price: \$33.00 all expos, PLUS \$103.00 group fee

The Louvre or Louvre Museum is one of the world's largest museums and a historic monument. Nearly 35,000 objects from prehistory to the 21st century are exhibited over an area of 60,600 square meters (652,300 square feet). With more than 8 million visitors each year, the Louvre is the world's most visited museum.

CLIMB THE STAIRS AT THE ARC DE TRIOMPHE Price: Approx. \$20.00 Adults, free under 18

Welcome to the top of the arc de triomphe of Paris, the only highest peak of the Champs-Elysées. at 60 meters above sea level it offers one of the most beautiful views of the capital. Located on the far west of the Champs Élysées, it rules over the most beautiful avenue of the world. The Eiffel Tower, the Place de la Concorde, the area of la Défense: few symbolic monuments of Paris are not visible from this 360° viewpoint at the center of the Place Charles de Gaulle-Etoile.

EIFFEL TOWER

Prices: \$28.00 2nd Floor and \$43.00 top of tower

The Eiffel Tower is an iron lattice tower located on the Champ de Mars in Paris. It was named after the engineer Gustave Eiffel, whose company designed and built the tower. Erected in 1889 as the entrance arch to the 1889 World's Fair, it has become both a global cultural icon of France and one of the most recognizable structures in the world. The tower is the tallest structure in Paris. Note: The Eiffel Tower Tour sells out fast. We encourage you to ask us to pre-book this as soon as you can. Please note that we cannot pre-book this excursion because of security issues.

CHATEAU DE VERSAILLES (CLOSED ON MONDAY) Price: Adults \$31.00 and under 18s free (ID required).

The Palace of Versailles is a royal château in Versailles in the Île-de-France region of France. The Court of Versailles was the center of political power in France from 1682, when Louis XIV moved from Paris until the royal family was forced to return to the capital in October 1789 after the beginning of the French Revolution. Versailles is therefore famous not only as a building but as a symbol of the system of absolute monarchy of the Ancien Régime. We advise you to arrive when the Estate opens. Your visit must be made on the date indicated on the ticket.

CHAMPS ELYSEES AND ARC DE TRIOMPHE

Price: Free

Possibly the most famous road in the world, the Champs-Élysées is a picturesque tree-lined avenue that runs from

the Arc de Triomphe towards the Louvre.
It is an incredibly romantic place and a real symbol of Paris and France.
The Arc de Triomphe is a stunning war monument that was commissioned by Napoleon in 1806 to honor his great victories.



CATACOMBS OF PARIS

Prices: Booking is mandatory 8 weeks in advance. Groups (minimum 10 people, maximum 20 people, booking is required) \$44.00 per person, U18'S \$19.00.

Through an in-depth path, the visitors discover the area thoroughly, like Décure's sculptures, the quarry footbath, the Sacellum Crypt, the spuchral lamp, and Gilbert's tomb. The Catacombs of Paris are underground ossuaries in Paris, France which hold the remains of over six million people in a small part of the ancient Mines of Paris tunnel network. Located south of the former city gate "Barrière d'Enfer" (Gate of Hell) beneath Rue de la Tombe-Issoire, the ossuary was founded when city officials were faced with two simultaneous problems: a series of cave-ins starting in 1774 and overflowing cemeteries, particularly Saint Innocents.

STADIUM TOUR OF PARC DES PRINCES

Price: Approx. \$40.00 per person.

Walk in the footsteps of the heroes of Paris Saint-Germain, from the top of the stands to the substitutes' bench, from the VIP boxes to the conference room, passing through the locker room, the Presidential Square and the fabulous wall of trophies... The Parc des Princes like you've never seen!
