England – London and Manchester area

Travel dates:

April 11-21, 2024.

Itinerary:

- April 11 Departure from NYC airport.
- April 12 Arrival London airport. Transfer to your accommodation.
- April 13 Sightseeing London. Options include The Tower of London, The Houses of Parliament, Buckingham Palace and The London Eye, with its spectacular views over London. Afternoon/evening visit to a EPL match (ticket not included in price). Options include: Chelsea vs. Everton, West Ham vs. Fulham and Arsenal vs. Aston Villa.
- April 14 Optional visit Hampton Court Palace and Windsor Castle. For almost 200 years, Hampton Court Palace was at the center of court life, politics and national history. Windsor Castle is an official residence of The Queen and the largest occupied castle in the world.
- April 15 Enjoy the day sightseeing in London. Options include a visit to the Chelsea Village MegaShop and Stamford Bridge Stadium, Trafalgar Square and Covent Garden shopping precinct, Emirates and/or Wembley Stadium.
- April 16 Day at leisure for more sightseeing in London. Possible evening visit to a mid-week pro match or possible Champions League match (pending schedule and availability – tickets not included in price).
- April 17 Transfer to your accommodation in Manchester. En-route optional stop at St. George's Park (English FA national soccer center) for a tour of their facilities, or optional stop in Chester. Chester is a magical city over 2000 years old; it is the most complete walled city in Britain. Walk the walls – 2 miles of entirely walk able walls, studded with historic towers and a bird's eye view of the city center. Look over the other side of the wall for a view of the Welsh mountains in the distance. Afterwards you can head for the Roman Amphitheater and The Chester Cathedral (14th century church).
- April 18 Sightseeing Manchester. One of the most popular sights is the Old Trafford stadium, home of Manchester United and the English National Football (Soccer) Museum.
- April 19 More sightseeing Manchester, or sightseeing in Liverpool. See popular sights like Royal Albert Dock, Liverpool Cathedral and/or do an optional stadium tour of Anfield, home of Liverpool FC.
- April 20 Day at leisure for sightseeing in Manchester. Afternoon/evening visit to a EPL match (ticket not included in price). Options include: Manchester United vs. Newcastle or Sheffield United vs. Burnley.
- April 21 Transfer to London or Manchester airport. Return flight.

Sport program inclusion and options:

We have not included any team sport/soccer program or games, but can offer the following soccer options:

- We can arrange training sessions with youth academy coaches from English pro clubs like Manchester City, Everton FC, Tottenham Hotspurs or Fulham FC. Supplement for a 2-hour session, including field hire, is approx. \$650.00 total.
- Subject to availability we might be able to arrange a tour of St. George's Park, headquarters of the English FA. Approx. \$15-\$20 per person.
- We can arrange tickets for pro games, subject to availability. Ticket costs will depend on the game, but usually ticket costs range from approx. \$75.00-\$150.00 per person depending on the game.
- Visit and tour of a pro team stadium – between \$25.00 and \$30.00 per person.

Accommodation and meals included:

The London Eye is a giant Ferris wheel on the South Bank of the River Thames in London, England. The entire structure is 35 meters (443 ft) tall, and the wheel has a diameter of 120 meters (394 ft). It is the tallest Ferris wheel in Europe, and includes a 30-minute rotation, Samsung interactive capsule guides, and entry to 4D cinema experience.

3) **TOWER OF LONDON - 2024**

The massive White Tower is a typical example of Norman military architecture, whose influence was felt throughout the kingdom. It was built on the Thames by William the Conqueror to protect London and assert his power. The Tower of London – an imposing fortress with many layers of history, which has become one of the symbols of royalty – was built around the White Tower.

[3] Beyond this is an extensive museum area, which combines an exhibition of some 800 finds from the site with interactive displays and the opportunity to learn about tenth-century life and to discuss it with "Viking" staff. Among the exhibits is a replica of the Coppergate Helmet, which was found near the site of the center and is now in the Yorkshire Museum.
